Thank you for participating in the Facebook research panel!


This guide will explain how to install the Facebook Research app, certificate and VPN. All of these must be installed and running to take part in the research.

To begin, you will need to install and setup the research app.


- 1. Open the link you've received to install the Facebook Research software. The link should look similar to this URL: http://i.diawi.com/a9Koi1
- 2. This will download the research software to your device. Once you get a notification that the download is complete, tap that notification to install it. If you dismissed the notification, search for the "spaceship" in your downloads or files folder, or download the app again.




If an "Install Blocked" warning appears, go to **Settings > Security**. Scroll down to **Unknown sources** and tap the toggle next to it.




Tap **OK** and open the file again.




3. Tap Install (this could take a few minutes).




4. Once you see the "App installed" message, tap **Open**.



5. In the app, type in your invitation code and tap OK.



6. After reading the research details, approve your participation by checking all checkboxes and tapping **OK**.




7. In the next screen, tap **OK** to setup the Facebook Research certificate.




8. If you don't have a PIN code set for your lock screen, you'll need to set one up now.



Tap **OK** and then tap on **PIN**.




Enter a 4-digit PIN code, tap **Continue** and re-enter the PIN code for confirmation. Choose a code you can easily remember, since you'll need it every time you open your phone. Tap **Done**.




You might get a notification confirming the certificate was successfully installed. You can dismiss this notification, and it might reappear when restarting your phone.

9. In the next screen, tap \mathbf{OK} to allow the VPN connection request.




You'll now see an icon shaped like a key in your phone's status bar.


10. In the next screen, tap **OK** to start the process of activating the accessibility permission.




11. Once you tap **OK**, the Accessibility section of your phone's settings will open on your screen. Find the Services section on the Accessibility page. You might need to scroll to the bottom to locate Services.




Tap on Facebook Research in the Services section and tap to turn permission ON.




If you receive an Android system message after enabling the permission, press **OK**. You might be asked to re-enter your PIN.



12. After you tap **OK**, you will automatically return to the Facebook Research app in order to allow the app usage access permission. Tap **OK** to start the process of allowing app usage access.



The app usage section of your phone's settings will open on your screen. Tap on Facebook Research.



Tap Facebook Research to turn the permission **ON**.



If you receive an Android system message after enabling the permission, please press **OK**. You might be asked to re-enter your PIN.

13. If you return to the Facebook Research app, you will see a "Successfully installed!" screen. You can continue using your phone normally. As long as you don't remove the app or certificate, and the key icon appears in your status bar, you can participate in the research.
